We Are Proud of Our Uniform

Newling Public School is a full uniform school. This means that we wear the uniform on each school day, and we wear it with pride. The school community, through the P and C, endorses and completely supports the wearing of full uniform.

Part of the uniform is the appropriate footwear. For the summer and winter uniform, black school shoes

are to be worn. Black leather shoes are preferred, but black sports style shoes are also acceptable. This option is also convenient when children are doing PE lessons or involved in physical activity during breaks.

When wearing the sports uniform students can wear sports shoes or 'joggers'. Sports uniform should only be worn on Fridays. The correct footwear ensures safety for a variety of school activities and must be worn for school excursions.

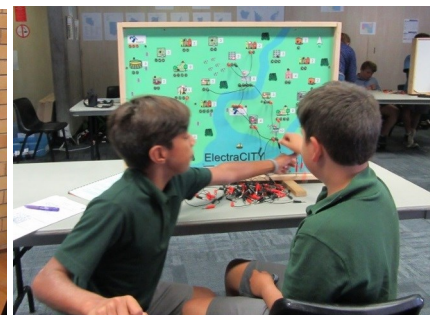
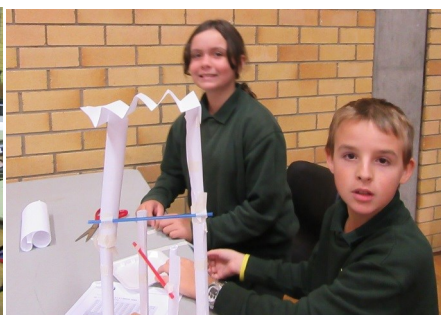
Easter Raffle
