



#### **Gathering**

#### **Morning Duty**

We still have a few students that are arriving too early. Please remember that supervision for the morning starts at **8.30am** with Breakfast Club and a teacher on duty. We ask you **do not send them earlier** than this as there is no supervision and their safety could be at risk.











## 3/4 News


